4. What does Kierkegaard argue in *Fear and Trembling*, and what exactly is a “teleological suspension of the ethical”? Do you agree with his existential analysis? Use five additional sources in your discussion.
5. Who was Dostoevsky, and why is he considered an existentialist? Do you find his controversial philosophy compelling? Why or why not? Use five additional sources in your discussion.
6. What does Dostoevsky depict in *Notes from Underground*, and how does this work illustrate existential themes? What do you make of this text? Use five additional sources in your discussion.
7. Who was Nietzsche, and why is he considered an existentialist? Do you find his controversial philosophy compelling? Why or why not? Use five additional sources in your discussion.
8. What does Nietzsche argue in *On the Genealogy of Morals*, and what exactly is the difference between the “master” and “slave” moralities? Do you agree with his existential analysis? Use five additional sources in your discussion.
